



Persian Annual Clover

Persian is another annual clover option. It is native to countries in the middle-east and performs well in summer-dry areas.

Persian is a late flowering annual and can be either sown in the spring or autumn as a special purpose forage crop or in seed mixes with annual ryegrasses, forage cereals or brassicas as a highly nutritive plant.

Lightning

Lightning is a soft-seeded, late-season Persian clover

- » Well suited to irrigation and summer rainfall
- » Tolerates water-logging
- » Thin-walled, hollow stems
- » Very high potential production and can be grazed or multi-cut
- » High palatability and digestibility, and free of oestrogen risks
- » Good companion for annual ryegrass
- » Sow at a seeding rate of 10 kg/ha if alone or 3 kg/ha in a mixture

Moa™

A high performing, persistent cultivar - New for 2017



- » Moa™ is a new Persian clover sold under licence from Grasslanz Technology Limited
- » Produced over 25% more dry matter than Lightning in 2015/16 summer trials
- » High ME content and improved digestibility levels
- » Moa™ is later flowering than other Persian clovers which is a key advantage in higher summer rainfall/irrigation areas, enabling the plant to produce higher quality vegetative feed longer into the growing season
- » Demonstrates greater persistency than other Persian clovers
- » Very upright in its growth habit which makes it an excellent companion for Intimidator™ Forage Oats
